## DEAR ATTENDEES,

The Colorado Health Foundation's Health Coverage goal is that all Coloradans achieve stable, affordable and adequate health coverage by 2023. Since our state expanded Medicaid and opened Connect for Health Colorado three years ago, our uninsured rate has dropped from 14.3 percent to 6.7 percent. Nearly 500,000 Coloradans are more likely to access the care they need, due in large part to your dedication to helping them learn their options and assisting them with enrollment. That is a phenomenal accomplishment.

Every single newly insured individual requires multiple touches before gaining coverage – through messaging, outreach, eligibility and enrollment.
